Volunteers are involved in all aspects of the Museum's mission from hosting VIP tours for various groups to working events, or even promoting the Museum at off-site events. The minimum service requirement for all volunteers is 50 hours per year.

Volunteers lead guided Museum tours for scheduled groups: schools, car clubs, senior groups etc. Additional duties include serving as greeters, informing visitors about our displays and programs; promoting Museum memberships; providing guests with assistance as needed; representing The Cobra Experience on and off site at Museum events and car shows; and, assisting other Museum departments as needed. Volunteers may also help in the office with various tasks. Volunteer training is a 1 day commitment followed by a two month provisional period under the mentorship of a veteran volunteer. Volunteers must be willing to commit to one year of service.
